

WellStar School of Nursing Clinical Requirements

- 1.) Use the KSU immunization form or your immunization record to show the following information:

TB Testing: negative TB Test (PPD, QuantiFERON Gold or TSpot) must be within the last year. The blood tests are highly recommended, but not required. If there is a history of TB, you must supply a copy of the annual symptom-free screen or the lab results of a QuantiFERON test. If not symptom free, we need a new chest x-ray. Lab results are required for the blood tests. **This is an annual requirement.**

Tetanus-Diphtheria-Pertussis (TDAP) immunization/booster: Proof of a Tetanus/Diphtheria/Pertussis immunization or booster received within the last 10 years. Proof **must** include month, day and year. *Please note: A two-year time period is recommended between tetanus/diphtheria and tetanus/diphtheria/pertussis.*

Varicella (Chicken Pox): Proof of 2 vaccinations or **laboratory** evidence of immunity, (reactive) quantitative titer. If you are in the process of getting the immunizations, please show documentation.

Measles, Mumps & Rubella (MMR): Proof of 2 vaccinations or **laboratory** evidence of immunity, (reactive) quantitative titer for each measles, mumps and rubella. If you are in the process of getting the series of immunizations, please show documentation.

Hepatitis B Series (HBV): **laboratory** evidence of immunity, reactive Hep B surface antibody (titer & values) and documentation of appropriate immunization. There are 3 injections at prescribed intervals or documentation that the series is in progress will be accepted. Within 6 weeks of the series being completed documentation of the titer is required.

Flu Vaccination: Proof of current flu vaccination administration (not just proof of purchase) is due by October 1st for Fall and upon entry for Spring.

COVID 19 Vaccination: Several of our clinical partners require evidence of the COVID 19 vaccination. To be credentialed if you are assigned to one of those sites, you will need evidence of the COVID vaccination.

- 2.) You are required to complete Criminal Background Check & Drug Test using Advantage Students (www.advantagestudents.com). Some facilities require this be renewed every two years.
- 3.) A signed copy (front and back) of current BLS card – **American Heart Association – Healthcare Providers Course only** – **NO EXCEPTIONS**
- 4.) Copy (front and back) of current health insurance card.
- 5.) Bloodborne Modules (<http://www.medcomrn.com/kennesaw/>). Only the three modules concerning Bloodborne issues are required, the login is your KSU ID number and the password is **nursing**. Complete the modules and print the completion certificates. **This is annual requirement.**
- 6.) Copy of your current Nursing License. Update as necessary.

*Health Records must be kept up to date. TB Testing and Bloodborne pathogen modules are annual requirements, CPR is every 2 years, and Tdap is every 10 ten years. Use the WellStar School of Nursing Health Form to record the above information though you may attach forms from your health care provider with lab results.
